2009 NACE and CARS Online Attendee Registration Opens with No Price Increase over 2008 Fees

Dallas / June 18, 2009 — Online attendee registration is now open for 2009 NACE and CARS with no increase in prices over 2008 fees for packages and sessions. Attendees can access the online registration for each event via their independent websites (www.NACEexpo.com and www.CARSevent.com). The upcoming International Autobody Congress & Exposition (NACE) and the Congress of Automotive Repair & Service (CARS) are sponsored by Automotive Service Association (ASA), are co-located at the Mandalay Bay Convention Center in Las Vegas, Nevada, November 4-7 and take place during the second annual Automotive Service & Repair Week (ASRW). Auto Glass Week is also co-located during ASRW and features exhibits, education and competitions for the auto glass professional.

Registration Options

Conference sessions are ticketed events and seating is limited. Early registration is encouraged to ensure access to any and all chosen sessions. Whether attendees are planning for a single day or the entire four day event, there’s a registration package for them. Colorful graphics have been added to the online registration process to help distinguish NACE and CARS sessions, sessions that are suitable for all, as well as track indicators.

The best value, the Super Pass (starting at \$285) includes sessions in all available timeslots, one reception, opening general session/keynote, expo, commemorative bag and pin. The Wednesday Day Pass (starting at \$200) includes sessions in all available Wednesday timeslots, one reception and expo. The Expo Pass (starting at \$10) includes admittance to NACE and CARS exhibits. Additional options are available for the purchase of individual session tickets (starting at \$60), I-CAR Technical Training (\$85/class), PCI program (\$50) and key events (NACE and CARS receptions at \$50 each and opening general session/keynote at \$25). Conference sessions and key events are available to all, whether attendees primarily represent the mechanical or collision segment of the industry. More than 80 sessions are offered collectively in the NACE and CARS education program with many tracks and topics crossing segment boundaries and catering to any industry professional. Note that all starting prices above are based on registrations received on or before the early cut-off date of September 17, 2009.

Free ASE Test Prep Classes for both mechanical and collision testing will again be available. Plus free education throughout the three Expo days, right on the show floor, including exhibitor-led educational theaters, product demonstrations, roundtable discussions, I-CAR Technology Showcase clinics, as well as all the Auto Glass Week activities including Auto Glass Expo (AGX) exhibits, demos and technician competitions.
